Bladder	All	Submit all pertinent medical records, operative/pathology reports, current oncological status report, including tumor markers, and any other testing deemed necessary report, include duration of symptoms, name and dosage of drugs and side effects	<p>Initial Special Issuance - Requires FAA Decision</p> <p>Followup Special Issuance - See AASI Protocol (http://www.faa.gov/about/office_org/headquarters_offices/avs/offices/aam/ame/guide/special_iss/all_classes/bladder_cancer/)</p>
Other Neoplastic Disorders	All	Submit a current status report, all pertinent medical reports to include staging, metastatic work up, and operative report if applicable	Requires FAA Decision
Prostatic Cancer	All	Review a current status report, all pertinent medical reports to include staging, PSA, metastatic workup, and operative report, if applicable, and treatment	<p>For prostate cancer without evidence of extra-capsular disease - Issue and warn for adverse change in disease and extra-capsular spread/metastases.</p> <p>All others require FAA Decision. Submit all evaluation data.</p> <p>Initial Special Issuance - Requires FAA Decision</p> <p>Followup Special Issuances - See AASI Protocol (http://www.faa.gov/about/office_org/headquarters_offices/avs/offices/aam/ame/guide/special_iss/all_classes/prostate_cancer/)</p>
Renal Carcinoma	All	Review all pertinent medical records, operative/pathology reports, current oncological status report, including tumor markers, and any other testing deemed necessary report, include duration of symptoms, name and dosage of drugs and side effects	<p>See Renal Cancer Worksheet. (http://www.faa.gov/about/office_org/headquarters_offices/avs/offices/aam/ame/guide/media/C-CACIRenalCancer.pdf) (PDF) If airman meets all certification criteria - Issue.</p> <p>All others require FAA decision. Testicular Carcinoma	All	Review all pertinent medical records, operative/pathology reports, current oncological status report, and any other testing deemed necessary report, include	<p>If treatment is complete without sequela and airman is back to full activities of daily living - Issue.</p> <p>All others require FAA Decision. Submit all evaluation data.</p> <p>Initial Special Issuance - Requires FAA Decision</p> <p>Followup Special Issuances - See AASI Protocol (http://www.faa.gov/about/office_org/headquarters_offices/avs/offices/aam/ame/guide/special_iss/all_classes/testicular_cancer/)</p>
